

ABOUT THE ELSWICKS

Meet our Missionaries of the Month: Tony & Amber Elswick!

Where do the Elswicks serve?

Tony & Amber, along with their four daughters, serve as missionaries in Panama, Central America.

What kind of work do the Elswicks do as missionaries?

The Elswick's main ministry is in training local pastors and church leaders so that they can minister to their own communities. One of the locations they are serving is in La Reserva, Panama, which is a community in the Darien Jungle. This community has not had a local church or pastor in 30 years! The Elswicks are also training leaders in Panama City, Panama while working alongside a local church plant in the heart of the city.

Before they moved to Panama, the Elswicks served as missionaries in Nicaragua. They continue to have study groups in the greater Managua, Nicaragua area.

Which mission organization are the Elswicks serving through?

The Elswick's serve through Mission to the World (MTW). MTW is the global missions-sending agency of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA). To learn more about MTW, visit: mtw.org.
